191,977 providers and staff respondents


12 areas of patient safety culture assessed in the survey

average percent positive of all 12 areas 65%

Areas of strength for most hospitals




82% of respondents reported that they work well together as a team



Supervisor/Manager Expectations & **Actions for Promoting Patient Safety**

80% of respondents indicated that supervisors/managers consider staff suggestions and do not overlook patient safety problems

Areas of potential for improvement for most hospitals



Handoffs and Transitions


48% of respondents indicated that information is not lost during transfers or shift changes



Nonpunitive Response to Error

49% of respondents indicated that event reports are not held against them and that mistakes are not kept in their personnel file
