BMI Follow-up

Measure 5: Parent Report of Discussion of Weight Concerns for Child

Description

The percentage children with a BMI ≥85th percentile and an outpatient care visit whose parents were surveyed and reported that their provider discussed their child's weight or body mass index (BMI) in the last 12 months. A higher proportion indicates better performance.

Calculation

This measure requires medical record and parent survey data and is calculated as follows:

The percentage of eligible children whose parents reported that their provider discussed their child's weight or BMI (numerator divided by denominator).

Definitions	
Intake period	January 1 of the year prior to the measurement year through December 31 of the measurement year.
Parent-reported Discussion	This is defined as an affirmative response to the question: "In the last 12 months, did your child's healthcare provider discuss any concerns/worries about your child's weight or body mass (BMI)?"
Outpatient care	A Health Maintenance Exam (HME) or an Evaluation and Management (E&M) visit with primary care provider or a specialist (see Table 5-A).
